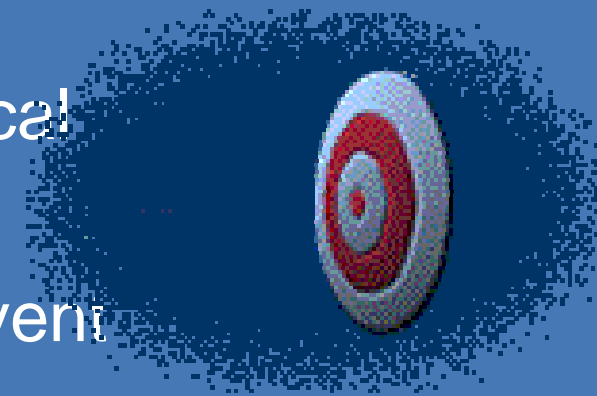

- understand the importance of maintaining a permanent infrastructure to ensure their plan is ready when an event occurs.



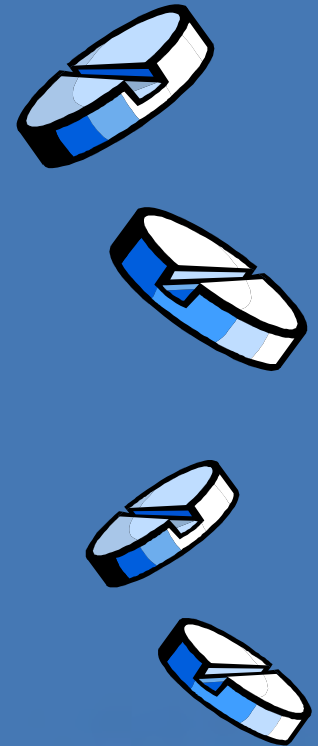

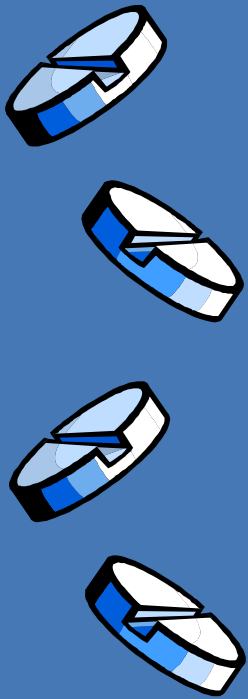

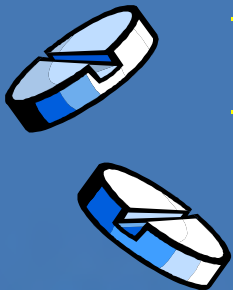
